Separate sealed proposals will be received until 11:00 A.M. prevailing time on December 11, 2001 at the Yaphank Office of Charles Bartha, P.E., Commissioner of Public Works, 335 Yaphank Avenue, Yaphank, New York, 11980, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for the:

which is a single contract project consisting of all work as indicated in the Project Manual.

A full refund will be made to PROPOSERS for return of one set of Drawings and Project Manual, a 50% refund will be made for return of any additional sets. A 50% refund will be made to NON-PROPOSERS for each set returned. The successful proposer will receive a full refund for all sets. Drawings and Project Manual must be in good condition and must be returned within 30 days of award or rejection of proposals. Deposits on sets not returned within this period will be forfeited.

Each proposer must deposit with his proposal, security in an amount not less than 5% of the Total Estimated Capital Investment (from Schedule B of the Proposal Form) in the form of a Certified Check or Bid Bond.

Attention of the proposers is specifically directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, as well as to other provisions set forth in the Instructions to Proposers, General Conditions, with special attention to the Supplementary and Special Conditions.

Each proposer will be required to comply with the provisions of the Minority Business Enterprise Program as described herein.

The proposals shall be delivered in person by the proposer or his agent at the time and place stated. The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.
