

How to Delete Your Browser History in:

Internet Explorer 6

1. In the menu, click **Tools**.
2. Click **Internet Options...** A box will open.
3. In the middle of the box there is a section named Temporary Internet Files. Click the button marked **Delete Files**.
4. When the box pops up, tick the **Delete all offline content** box and then click **OK**.
5. Under History, click **Clear History**. This will clear the pages you've recently visited.
6. A box will ask you if you want to delete all items in your history folder. Click **Yes**.
7. Click **OK** to close the Internet Options box.

Internet Explorer 7 or Higher

1. Click on the **Tools** menu and select Internet Options.
2. In the General page under Browser History, select the **Delete** button.
3. Select the **Delete all** button at the bottom to clear everything.

Safari (Apple Macs)

You can reset Safari to clear the history, empty the cache, clear the Downloads window, and remove all cookies. It also removes saved usernames, passwords or other AutoFill data and clears Google/Yahoo search entries. To do this:

1. Click the **Safari menu option** at top left of the screen.
2. Choose **Reset Safari....** A box will appear.
3. Click the **Reset** button.

Firefox

1. Open **Options** (Windows) or **Preferences** (Mac) box and click on the **Privacy icon**.
2. Hit the **Clear Now** button located in the Private Data section. A new box will open with multiple options for clearing your history.

3. Check **any or all** of the boxes that will delete your Web history. You can choose to delete cookies, cache and browsing history.
4. Press the **Clear Private Data Now** button to delete all of your Web history.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Click on **Tools** in the menu bar, and then click **Options**.
2. You will then see the Firefox Options dialogue box, click on the **Privacy icon** and you will be presented with the Firefox Privacy settings.
3. Click Clear **Browsing History Now** button.

Opera

1. Navigate up to the top drop-down menus and click on **Tools** if you're using a **Windows system**. Then scroll down the list and click on **Preferences**. For **Mac users**, click on **Opera** at the top left corner of your screen, scroll down through the choices until you reach **Preferences** and click on it.
2. Look to see if the **advanced** tab is open. **If not**, click on it to continue with the process.
3. Click on the **History** link located on the left side of the window. Mac and Windows users can both follow this step.
4. Click the **Clear** button, and then the **Ok** button to delete all of your Web history.
