What is HPRP ?

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (the Recovery Act) established the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP). The program assists individuals and families at risk of homelessness and those who are presently homeless.

Can HPRP help me?

HPRP is a program that was designed to help those at the greatest risk of becoming homeless and those who can maintain stable housing after this program ends.

HPRP is:

- Income based / Needs Based
- Temporary Rental Assistance (up to 18 months)
- Rent & Utility Arrears (up to 6 months)
- Moving costs
- Legal Fees
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HPRP is NOT:

- Mortgage assistance
- Credit card debt
- Food
- Medical or Dental
- Cash assistance

The Town of Islip Community Development Agency and the Town of Babylon are working with the Suffolk County Department of Social Services to provide services under the HPRP program.
